How do I book this tour?

Booking is very easy! Simply follow the booking procedure by clicking on "Book Now". This will take you to the product page where you can reserve your place by paying a DEPOSIT. You will receive a confirmation of your booking and any queries will be dealt with using your e-mail provided. All major credit cards and paypal are accepted.

Where will we meet?

We will meet at the ferry dock on the Mull side. If you are driving then this would be the logical place to meet. If you want to find your own way to Scotland then please get in touch and we can get something arranged.

What flights do I take?

If you are coming from the UK, then you can drive. However, EasyJet have really inexpensive flights from most London airports to either Glasgow or Edinburgh

Do I need to hire a car?

Again, this depends on how to choose to travel to Mull. You can certainly drive yourself, or you could hire a car. Also if you want to use public transport please get in touch so we can sort something out.

What accommodation is included?

We will make use of a large property near Tobermory. This property has ample room for everyone and enough bathrooms to make your stay very comfortable.

What meals are included?

Meals are included as indicated. In summary all breakfasts and lunches are **included** while dinner is **excluded**. All drinks are **excluded**.

What camera and lenses are recommended?

Anything from 300-500mm will work for this tour, not forgetting an extender for additional reach. You will also want to bring some wider lenses for the other sights we will encounter, and of course we will be reaching for our mobile phones from time-to-time. A DSLR or a mirrorless camera is best.

Is a tripod necessary?

A tripod is not specifically required but some people prefer to work with one, so again this depends on you.

What costs outside of what's advertised should I prepare for?

You should budget for your flight, snacks and dinner. Also, any drinks you may need and anything of a personal nature that you may require. With this being part of the British Isles, cash (pounds sterling) and all major credit and debit cards are generally accepted by any merchants.

What will the weather be like?

At this time of year, we expect mild to warm climates in Scotland. However, rain is unpredictable, so be prepared.
