

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS SEAL PUPS IN NORFOLK

#### How do I book this tour?

Booking is very easy! Simply follow the booking procedure by clicking on "Book Now". This will take you to the product page where you can reserve your place by paying a DEPOSIT. You will receive a confirmation of your booking and any queries will be dealt with using your e-mail provided. All major credit cards and paypal are accepted.

# What flights do I take?

No flight is required for this experience.

## Do I need to hire a car?

Transportation is excluded from this trip, hence the need for a car depends on your own personal circumstances. This is considered a "local" trip within England and hence it is assumed that you will use your own transport to reach the meeting point.

#### What accommodation is included?

We will make use of a BNB property within 20mins of our photography location. There may be options for single occupancy and en-suite facilities – please enquire.

#### What meals are included?

Snacks and alcoholic drinks are excluded for this tour. However, we will be able to stop at local convenience stores to purchase these so that you do not have to bring this with you.

#### What camera and lenses are recommended?

Anything from 300-600mm should work for this tour. A wider lens will be great for the windmills and lighthouses - example 24mm

#### Is a tripod necessary?

A tripod is not required for the seals but is recommended for the lighthouses and windmills.

# What costs outside of what's advertised should I prepare for?

If parking at the Seals sites then there is a small fee applicable. Other than that any snacks and preferred drinks is for your account.

#### What will the weather be like?

This is the beginning of winter in the UK and temperatures can get quite cold in the mornings and late evenings. Also, near the ocean, temperatures can be significantly different to inland. However, the house we use for our accommodation is a home and will have heating and is well insulated from the cold as is normal in a UK house.

Average temperatures (probably): 8 to 0 degC Rainfall: 20mm (average for this time of year)
